for us our Heirs and Successors do give grant and confirm unto *Charles*
Boas Jun of Isle of Wight County our certain tract or parcel of Land
containing One hundred and twenty five Acres lying and being on the
South side of Nottoway River and on the South side of the said River
in the County aforesaid and bounded as followeth (to wit) *Beginning*
at a gum by the side of the said Crooke a Corner Tree of William *Boas* said
then by South side South Twenty One degree East One hundred and seven
poles to and Oak then South Five degrees West Twenty eight poles to
